Recommendations for New Section 106 Projects

1.0 Background

The 'Improve your Neighbourhood' scheme was developed as part of Active Communities' approach to managing growth, allowing new project ideas to be processed.

All submitted ideas are presented to a S106 working group and subjected to an approved scoring process by these sections-

- Green Spaces
- Recreation Services
- Sports Development Service
- Landscape Architects
- Children & Young People Participation Service

Recommendations for inclusion on the S106 project list are made for ideas that fulfill a minimum 30% of the criterion. Once they have been approved as viable ideas, they are added to a project list and prioritised according to ward based strategic objectives.

Projects on this list are submitted to Community Services Scrutiny Committee and the Executive Councillor and may adopted for further development. Some projects considered as 'Quick Hits' (marked *), meaning that they are easily achievable and so may be developed alongside higher scoring projects.
