

EAST AREA Recommendations for New S106 Projects

1.0 Background

The 'Improve your Neighbourhood' scheme has been developed by Active Communities as a process to allow new recreation and open space project ideas to be developed.

All new project ideas are subject to a scoring process by these sections to ensure that they fulfill a minimum 30% of the required criterion-

- Green Spaces / Nature Conservation
- Recreation Services / Sports Development Service
- Landscape Architects / Safer Communities
- Children & Young People Participation Service

If approved as viable through Area Committee, ideas are added to a project list and presented to Scrutiny Committee. If adopted they are then subject to consultation and development.

1	Coleridge skateboarding and BMX-ing ramp/ Younger age group
2	Play equipment which children hang and swing along in Coleridge Rec
3	Paddling pool improvements Coleridge
4	Improvements to area around/next to pool. Coleridge
5	Stepping stones replaced with non-slip stepping stones that are positioned closer together Coleridge
6	Landscape improvements Coleridge
7	Coldhams Land play area - Improve disabled access & refurbishment
8	Velos Walk - redefine play area footprint
9	BMX and Improved Older Children Play Coldhams Lane
10	Barnwell Rec - Improved access, accessibility & landscape improvements
11	Tree planting along river & landscaping Stourbridge Common

12	Channel restoration and pond creation Stourbridge Common
13	Norman Cement Pits investigate access and LNR designation

CITYWIDE Project Recommendations in Priority Order

1	Kelsey Kerridge Refurbish Climbing Wall & build new bouldering wall
2	Jesus Green - path works / to main London Plane Ave
3	Christ Pieces - creation of winter garden along Pikes Walk
4	Floodlit all weather pitch at the University Sports Complex at Wilberforce Road/ access for public
5	Nest boxes scheme / Identify suitable council owned buildings for erection of boxes
6	Bee Friendly Areas
7	Demonstration Wildlife Garden / to show people how to plant one

3	Lighting scheme - Coldhams Common railway underpass	Not covered by s106 funding
4	City business / college biodiversity challenge. Run a competition to find biodiversity friendly business.	Fails to meet minimum criterion & would not be covered by s106 funding.
5	The Round Church The re-instatement of the railings around the perimeter wall.	Fails to meet minimum criterion & would not be covered by s106 funding.
6	Growing spaces for children and young people, with the support	Not covered by s106 funding

7	Slipways in various parts of the riverbank for canoeists	Not covered by s106 funding.
8	Coe Fen near the large brown Iron bridge. Improve folly and a brick boat shed area.	Not covered by s106 funding.
9	Biodiversity on allotments project/ increase native planting, beetle banks, pond, promote wildlife	No contributions available for Nature Conservation.
10	Street Furniture Review	Not covered by s106 funding.
