

SOUTH AREA Recommendations for New S106 Projects

1.0 Background

The 'Improve your Neighbourhood' scheme has been developed by Active Communities as a process to allow new recreation and open space project ideas to be developed. Anyone can submit ideas for schemes that they would like to see happen in their area.

All new project ideas are subject to a scoring process by these sections to ensure that they fulfill a minimum 30% of the required criterion-

- Green Spaces / Nature Conservation
- Recreation Services / Sports Development Service
- Landscape Architects / Safer Communities
- Children & Young People Participation Service

If approved as potentially viable through Area Committee, ideas are added to a project list and presented to Scrutiny Committee. If adopted they are then subject to full consultation.

SOUTH AREA Project Recommendations.

1	New full size astroturf at Long Rd - Support project with funding
2	Indoor sports facility at Long Rd - Support project with funding
3	Cricket Wicket Cherry Hinton
4	Cherry Hinton Village Centre Improvements installing raised beds, seating, covered area with removable sail canopies.
5	New Tennis Court Cherry Hinton
6	Limekiln Hill enhancements. Work with Netherhall School to establish a chalk grassland wildlife conservation area adjacent to Cherry Hinton Chalk pits.
7	Nine Wells LNR extension
8	Additional tree planting / spring bulbs Cherry Hinton
9	Enhance provision of sport Cherry Hinton
10	Lake/Pond restoration area Cherry Hinton
11	Manage/enhance existing woodland/pond/watercourses Cherry Hinton

CITYWIDE Project Recommendations.

1	Kelsey Kerridge Refurbish Climbing Wall & build new bouldering wall
2	Jesus Green Path Works / to main London Plane Ave
3	Christ Pieces - creation of winter garden along Pikes Walk
4	Floodlit all weather pitch at the University Sports Complex at Wilberforce Road/ access for public
5	Nest boxes scheme / Identify suitable council owned buildings for boxes
6	Bee Friendly Areas
7	Demonstration Wildlife Garden / to show people how to plant one.

SOUTH AREA & CITYWIDE Project ideas scoring below minimum criteria & not recommended for inclusion.

1	Bowls Green Cherry Hinton	Fails to meet minimum criterion but would be covered by s106 funding.
2	Restore historic parterre gardens Cherry Hinton	Fails to meet minimum criterion but would be covered by s106 funding.

SOUTH AREA & CITYWIDE Project ideas not eligible for s106 funding.

***These submitted projects are not eligible for s106 funding as advised by the Planning & Obligations Team. They may however be suitable for other funding sources such as environmental improvement.**

1	Trumpington Youth Shelter	Not covered by s106 funding.
2	City business / college biodiversity challenge. Run a competition to find most biodiversity friendly business.	Fails to meet minimum criterion & would not be covered by s106 funding.
3	The Round Church The re-instatement of the railings around the perimeter wall.	Fails to meet minimum criterion & would not be covered by s106 funding.
4	Growing spaces for children and young people, with the support of the community, to grow vegetables.	Not covered by s106 funding.
5	Slipways in various parts of the riverbank for canoeists	Not covered by s106 funding.
6	Coe Fen near the Iron bridge. A folly and a brick boat shed improvements	Not covered by s106 funding.
7	Biodiveristy on allotments project/ increase native planting, beetle banks, pond, wildlife.	No contributions available for Nature Conservation.
8	Street Furniture Review	Not covered by s106 funding.
