2 Progress to date

A report to Community Services Scrutiny Committee on the 13th November 2008 detailed that a review of the Strawberry Fair 2008 had taken place, considering the extent to which the previous agreed improvement plan had been successful and had involved consultation with stakeholders including Strawberry Fair Committee (SFC), local residents and the Police.

The decision to permit use of Midsummer Common for Strawberry Fair was taken on the 13th November 2008 as follows:

The Executive Councillor is recommended to approve the use of Midsummer Common by Strawberry Fair in 2009 with the following two caveats:-

I. Subject to agreement by the Strawberry Fair Committee to implement the specific conditions outlined in paragraph 3.27 i), ii) and iii) (detailed in the table below)

II. Officers are required to evaluate the extent to which the organisation of the 2009 event is successful in reducing public nuisance before considering permission for future events and to report back to the July 2009 meeting of the Community Services Scrutiny Committee.
