Initial rail service

- Served from a combination of Greater Anglia and Great Northern services.
- 4tph to Cambridge,1tph continuing to Liverpool Street and 2tph to King's Cross.
- 2tph to Ely, one continuing northbound to Norwich.

Monday - Friday

- The first GA service to depart Cambridge North for Liverpool Street will be the 06:04, arriving 07:25.
- The last GA service from Liverpool Street to Cambridge North will be the 22:28, arriving 23:57
- Capacity will improve when our new trains are introduced from 2019.





External facilities

- There will be 450 car park spaces for long and short stay, and disabled users.
- For those travelling to the station by bicycle there will be a 1000 space cycle shelter with solar panels mounted on the roof, providing up to 10% of the station's power.
- We must remind users that full size bikes are not to be carried on morning peak services into Cambridge and London stations.
- There will also be a taxi rank and designated area for dropping off





Internal facilities

- There will be a staff presence at the station from first to last service.
- Passengers will be able to purchase and collect tickets through three ticket vending machines (TVMs). Welcome hosts will be able to help passengers with any TVM queries.
- There is space for two retail units. An update will be provided once retail tenants have been selected.
- Toilets will be provided within the station building.
- Lifts will provide disabled access to all platforms and the main station building.
- There will also be cycle gutters on all stairwells to allow easier cycle carriage.
