PROPOSED CHANGES TO CHARTER MARKET REGULATIONS ON GENERAL & SUNDAY MARKET

Addendum to Committee Report

Section 2.2.5 explains that one of the recommendations is to ensure “that hot food and drink traders do not use single use plastics to dispense the food and drink that they sell.” There is no reference elsewhere in the committee report or its appendices to the term “single use plastics”. To clarify, the revision to the Charter Market Regulations states “21.8. All Traders selling take away hot food or drinks must use cardboard or paper based cups, trays, dishes or other packaging for their products.” The proposals are not seeking to ban, for example, plastic cutlery being provided.
