<p><b>5 Community Grants 2020-21</b></p>	<p>The Committee endorsed the recommendations.</p> <p>The Executive Councillor approved the Community Grants to voluntary and community organisations for 2020-21, as set out in Appendix 1 of this report, subject to the budget approval in February 2020 and any further satisfactory information required of applicant organisations.</p>
<p><b>6 Walking Tours</b></p>	<p>The Committee endorsed the recommendations.</p> <p>The Executive Councillor agreed to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Officially request Visit Cambridge and Beyond to include the management of walking tours in the development of their Destination Management Plan (DMP).</li> <li>ii. Approve the continuation of the monitoring of the sale and size of walking tours during the 2020 season in order to inform the development of the DMP.</li> <li>iii. Continue the dialogue with the County Council to examine the possibilities of coach permit parking in the city to include conditions to limit the numbers in any tour group.</li> <li>iv. Start a dialogue with the County Council to consider making park and ride sites more</li> </ul>

	<p>attractive to coach tours and to include incentives to direct groups from the sites to official walking tours of limited numbers.</p> <p>v. Use the outcomes from the negotiations to inform the development of the DMP.</p>
<p><b>7</b> <b>Review of Public Spaces Protection Order for Dog Control</b></p>	<p>The Committee endorsed the recommendations.</p> <p>The Executive Councillor:</p> <p>i. Approved in principle, the proposal to extend and vary the Order for dog control within Cambridge in the form set out at Appendix B [of the Officer's report] and the locations set out in Appendix C;</p> <p>ii. Authorised officers to publicise the proposed orders and to carry out consultation as required by the Act.</p>
<p><b>8</b> <b>Review Of Use Of The Regulation Of Investigatory Powers Act</b></p>	<p>The Committee endorsed the recommendations.</p> <p>The Executive Councillor</p> <p>i. Reviewed the Council's use of RIPA set out in paragraph 3.5 of the Officer's report.</p> <p>ii. Noted and endorsed the steps described in paragraph 3.7 and in Appendix 1 to ensure that surveillance is only authorised in accordance with RIPA.</p> <p>iii. Approved the general surveillance policy in Appendix 1 of the Officer's report.</p>
