

## Committee Action Sheet - North Area Committee (NAC)

1. Minute reference: **16/43/NAC Q5**

- Action: Pavements to Arbury Road in poor state of repair. Raise as priority.
- Lead Member: Cllr Scutt
- Progress:
  - Updated 6 November 2020 - Covid 19 proposals include one in relation to Arbury Road which would if it were to go ahead result in some work on the roadway and pavements - the moneys for this (if it is to go ahead) will be forthcoming from central government funds - therefore there is a wait on this matter although I continue to press for the matter to remain on the priority listing vis-a-vis the pavements along the length of the roadway.

2. Minute reference: **17/17/NAC**

- Action: Repairs to the second half of French's Road.
- Lead Member: Cllr Scutt
- Progress:
  - Updated 6 November 2020 - In regards to French's Road, the officer has been unable to determine what works were completed, so will re-evaluate (9/11/2020) and return to me with any plans to further improve the condition of the road. The County is submitting locations for the Micro Asphalt scheme programme so will add French's Road to suggestions if this is suitable.

3. Minute reference: **20/9/NAC Q2**

- Action: Obtain update from Network Rail on barrier downtime and business case to amend North Cambridge train station layout.
- Lead Member: Committee Manager
- Progress:
  - **28 February 2020** - Emailed Network Rail Officers – (chased 2/4/2020) no response to date. Chased 5/8/2020. Chased 6/11/2020.

4. Minute reference: **20/23/NAC**

- Action: To obtain a formal position statement regarding the use of mobility scooters in cycle lanes.
- Lead Member: County Cllr Manning.
- Progress:
  - Updated 19 November 2020 – Response from the Policy and Regulation Manager at the County Council.

All mobility scooters and powered wheelchairs can legally travel at a maximum of 4mph on footpaths or in pedestrian areas. You cannot drive any type of mobility scooter or powered wheelchair on bus lanes, cycle lanes, paths marked 'cycle only', or motorways.
