To consider a premises licence to:

- Sale of Alcohol – Sunday to Wednesday 12:00 to 00:30 hrs;
Thursday to Saturday 12:00 to 01:30 hrs.
- Live Music - Monday to Sunday 12:00 to 23:00 hrs;
- Recorded Music - Sunday to Wednesday 12:00 to 01:00 hrs;
Thursday to Saturday 12:00 to 02:00 hrs.

In making our decision we considered the following:

We found the following facts:

There was already a valid licence on the premises.
There had been discussions between the Applicant and the Police resulting in agreed conditions.

We did not consider the following matters to be relevant:

The resident petition on the need for a live music venue.
The parking issues.
The incidental community aspects.

Our reasons for this are:

Outside of the scope of the four licensing objectives.

Our decision is as follows:

To grant the licence subject to the mandatory conditions, those conditions offered by the Applicant and those conditions arising out of the discussions between the Applicant and the Police.

Our reasons for reaching the decision are as follows:

The existence of an active licence on the premises which has been transferred to the Applicant. The Sub Committee is satisfied that the conditions attached to the licence address the four licensing objectives.
