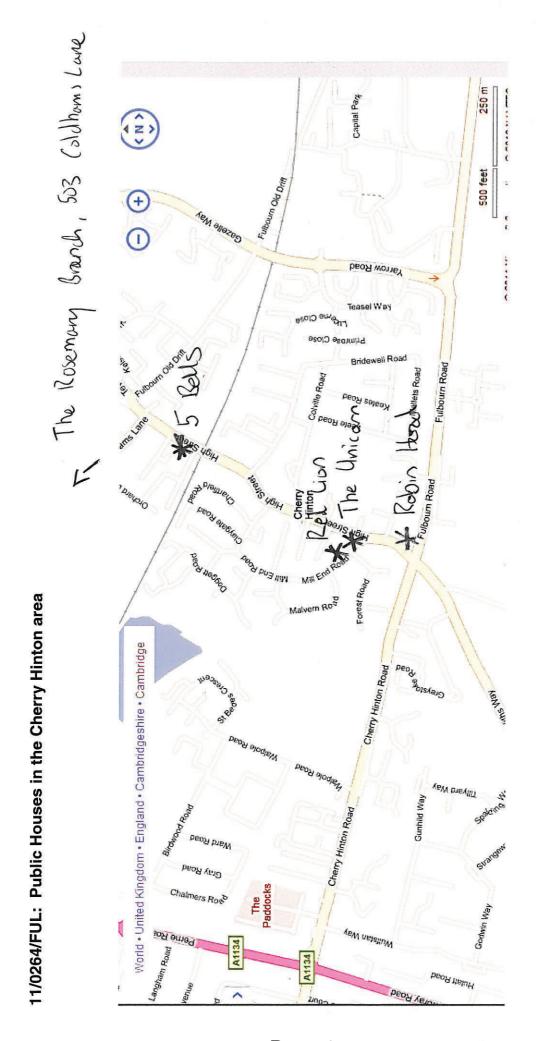
Revised condition 4

In light of the proximity of the site to Cherry Hinton Infants School, the following amendment to the collection and deliveries condition is suggested:

Except with the prior agreement of the local planning authority in writing, there should be no collection or deliveries to the site during the demolition and construction stages outside the hours of 0700 hrs and 1900 hrs on Monday - Saturday and there should be no collections or deliveries on Sundays or Bank and public holidays. In addition, there shall be no collection or deliveries between 0830 and 0930, and 1500 to 1600 Monday to Friday.

Reason: Due to the proximity of an infants school and residential properties to this premises. The above conditions are recommended to protect the amenity of these

premises throughout the redevelopment in accordance with policies 4/13 and 6/10 of the Cambridge Local Plan (2006)
