You Said – Priorities

- ASB associated with sex workers in Histon Road
- ASB and under age drinking in Kingsway Flats
- Dwelling burglary across neighbourhood
- Prevention of arson – e.g. Bin fires across the neighbourhood

We Did – Action Taken

- **Sex Worker ASB**
 - 350 hours of patrol
 - Behaviour challenged, dispersals
 - Link up with West Area team
 - Remains an issue – joint action continues

We Did – Action Taken

- **ASB Kingsway Flats**
 - 200 hours of patrols
 - Engagement with young people
 - Improved communications with residents
 - Considered no longer exceptional

We Did – Action Taken

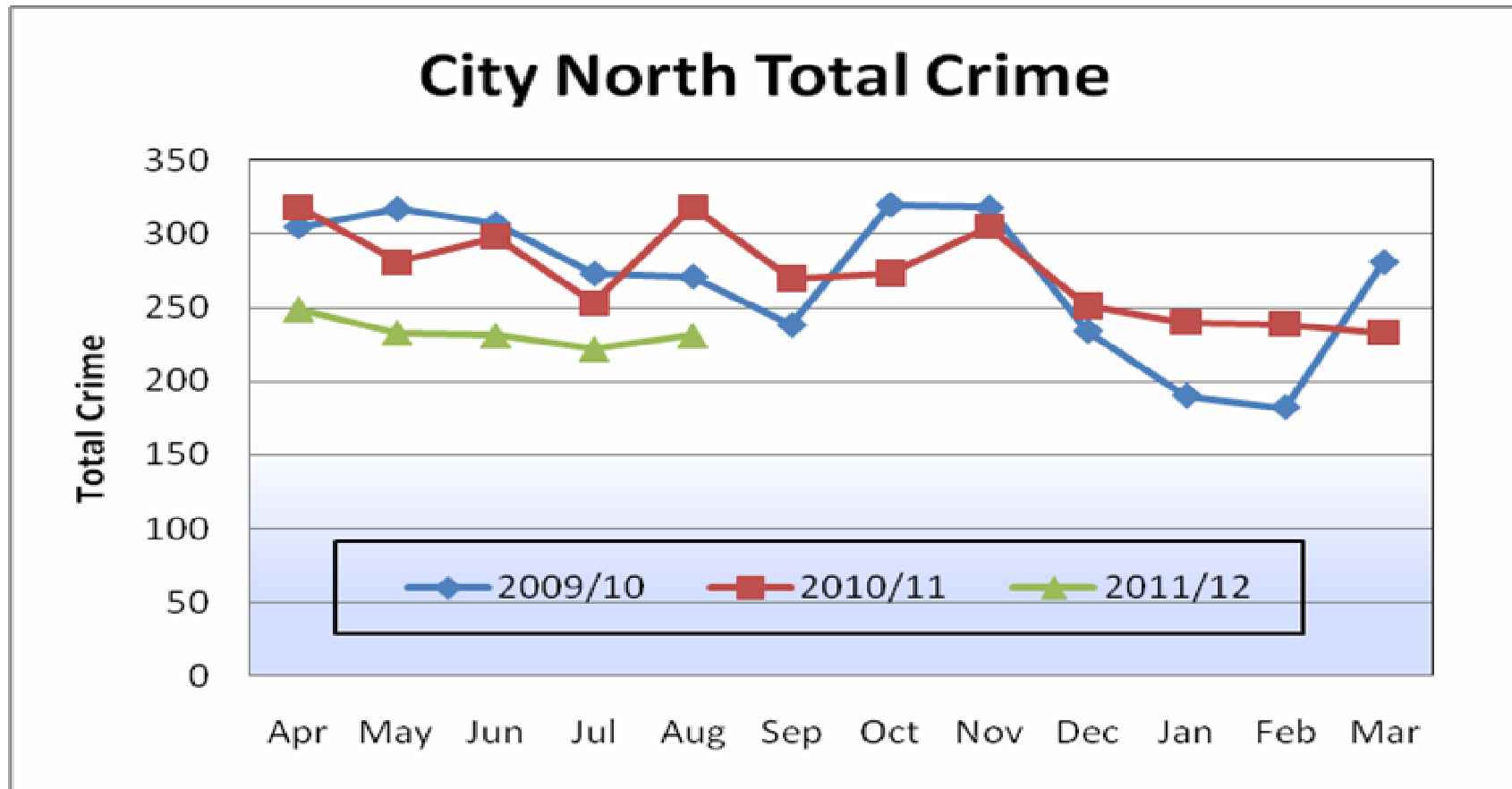
- **Dwelling Burglary**

- Trends and priorities considered every 14 days
- Tactical responses and incidents considered daily
- Focus given to those suspected of offending; those likely to start offending
- Support to those with addictions
- Offences have reduced

We Did – Action Taken

- **Prevention of Arson**
 - Identification of young people involved
 - Joint home visits made
 - Fire Setters Engagement Scheme
 - Preventative advice on storage of waste etc
 - Enforcement action – fly tipping
