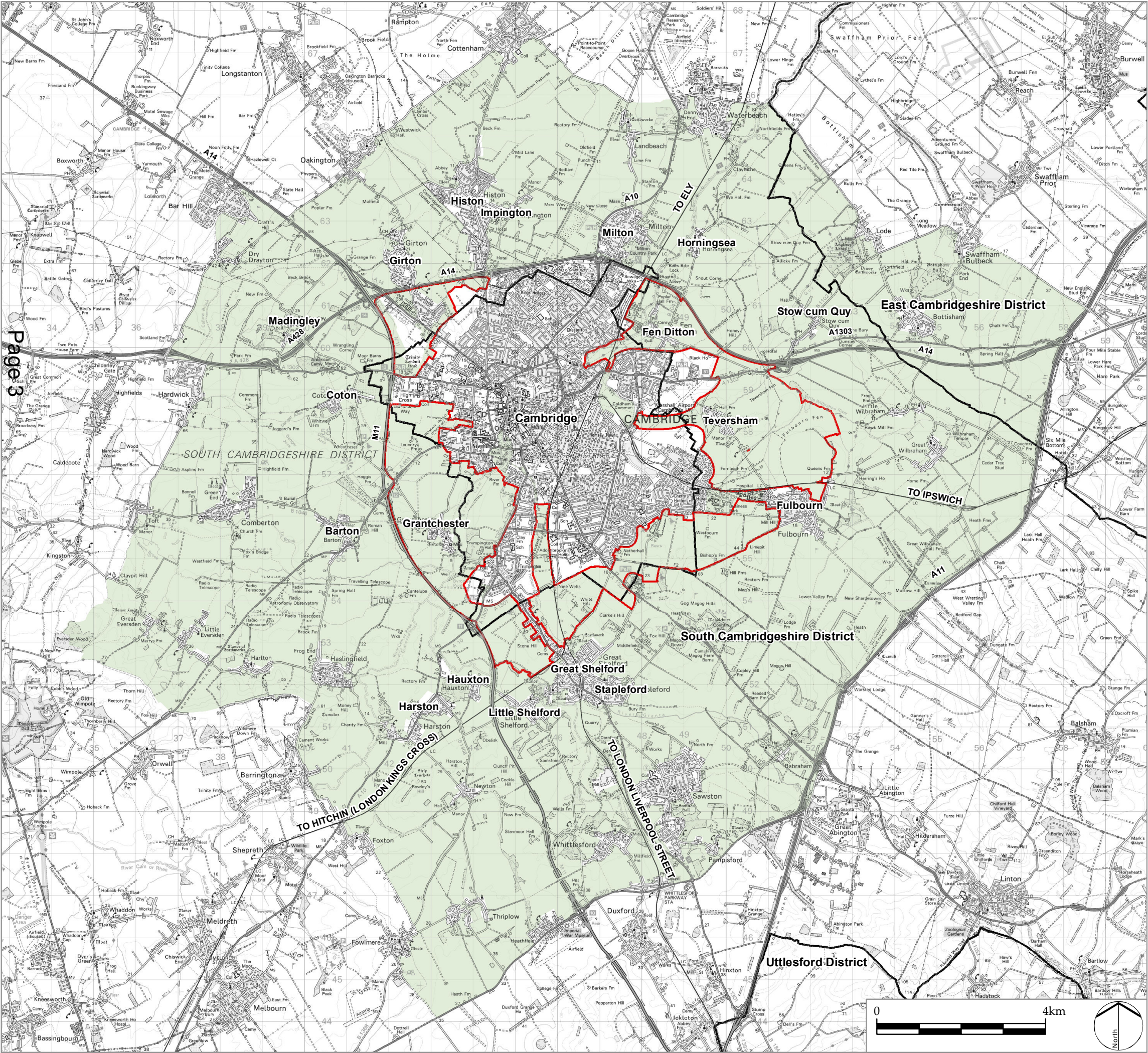
Figure 18: Photographs 7 and 8

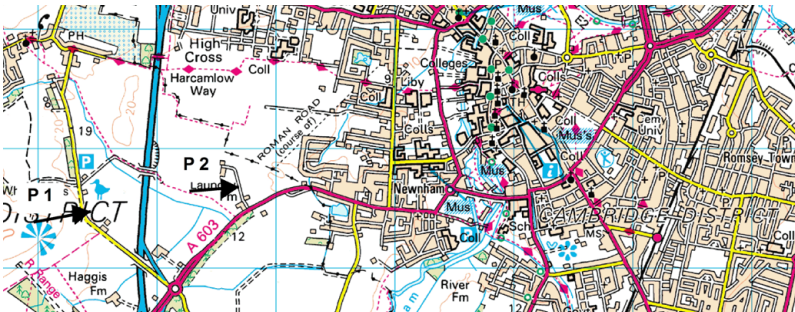
Photograph 1: Red Meadow Hill, Coton Country Park
This viewpoint allows elevated views across much of Cambridge, from higher ground on the edge of the Western Claylands. It demonstrates the compactness of the historic core of the city, with landmarks such as King's College and the University Library breaking the vegetated skyline and identifying the city centre. The green edge to the city is also clearly visible, with little of the built form of Cambridge seen through the vegetation and the rural foreground to the city (principally Sectors 3 and 4) seen in front of the vegetation. Higher ground to the south east and south of the city can also be seen in the distance, including the Gog Magog Hills.



Photograph 2: Arable land of Sector 3 west of the historic core
This viewpoint gives low level views of several key landmarks within the historic core, as well as views of the newer West Cambridge site. It demonstrates the soft green edge of Cambridge as seen from the western side of the city and highlights the proximity of the historic core to surrounding countryside. The view is across the rural foreground to the city, with Distinctive Cambridge, formed by Fellows' houses, Colleges and University buildings west of the historic core, immediately beyond.

Photograph 3: Arable land in Sector 4 north of Grantchester
This view is from a field entrance on Grantchester Road and provides the first view of landmarks within Cambridge just after leaving Grantchester. The well vegetated rural landscape, which is important to the setting of both Cambridge and Grantchester, is clearly apparent.

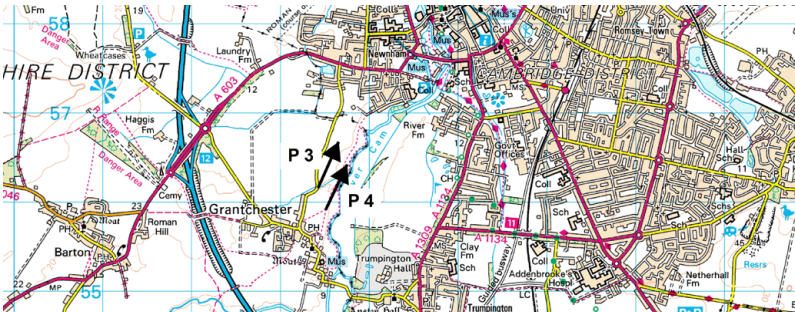


Photograph 4: Grantchester Meadows along the River Corridor
Views from Grantchester Meadows allow glimpses of the landmarks in the historic core of Cambridge, such as the Roman Catholic Church spire. The flood meadows form part of the River Cam corridor and are both a key feature of the setting of Cambridge and an important green approach to the city by foot, bicycle or river. This viewpoint highlights the rural character of the land which runs into Cambridge along the river corridor.

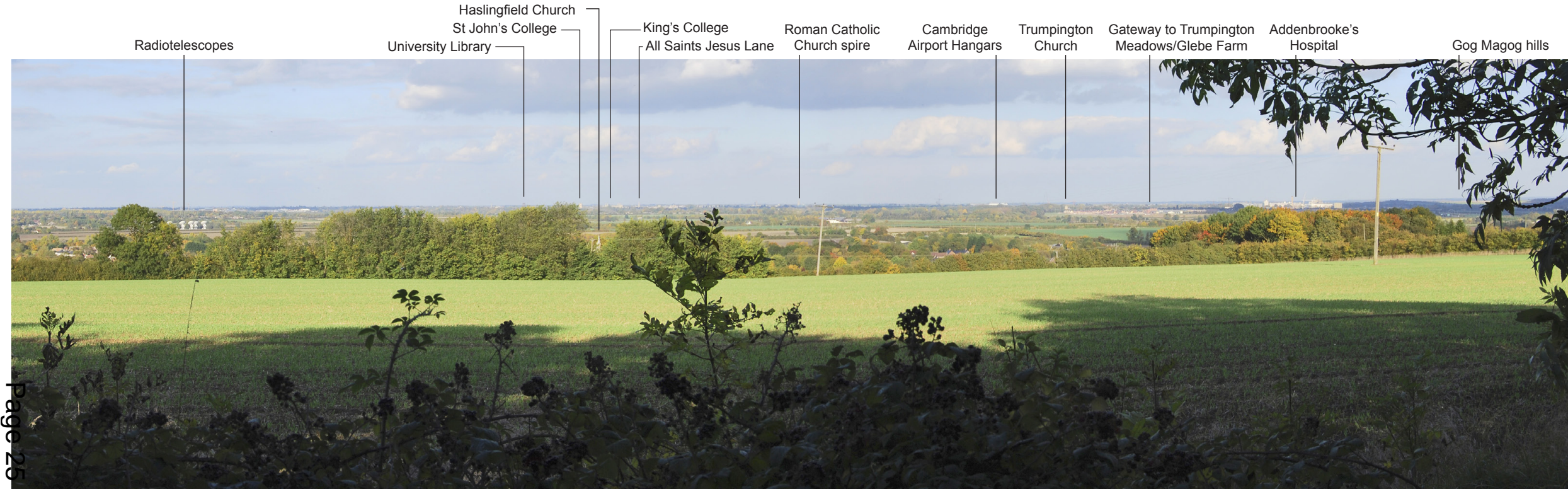

The elevated view from the public footpath west of Chapel Hill, on the Wimpole Ridge Chalk Hills, demonstrates the strong rural foreground to views of Cambridge from the south west. It also illustrates the location of the city in a bowl landform, enclosed by the Chalk Hills to the south and the Claylands to the west. The visibility of landmark features in the historic core demonstrate the compactness of this area of the city, with the soft green edge preventing views of much of the built areas of Cambridge.

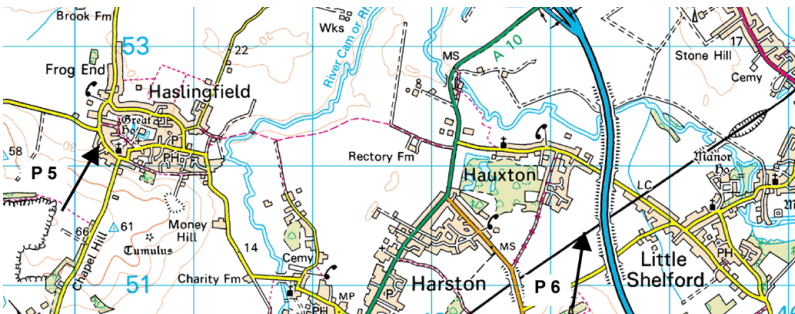


Photograph 6: St Margaret's Mount (Rowley's Hill)
This slightly elevated viewpoint, from the public footpath to the Gregory Wale Obelisk on St Margaret's Mount, also known as Rowley's Hill, allows views towards the south western edge of Cambridge. It shows the vegetated route of the M11, with the soft edge to Cambridge beyond. Church spires within the historic core of Cambridge are occasionally visible above the vegetation, with new development at Trumpington Meadows, Glebe Farm and Addenbrooke's Hospital also breaking the vegetation line.

Photograph 7: Magog Down
This elevated viewpoint on the edge of the Gog Magog Hills allows views across much of Cambridge. It demonstrates Cambridge's location within a bowl landform, surrounded by the Western Claylands and the Gog Magog Hills to the south. The soft green nature of the city is readily apparent from this location, with landmark features in the historic core rising above the vegetation. The reduced green edge at Addenbrooke's Hospital, as a result of ongoing development, seen across the rural landscape of Sector 10, is also noticeable from this view-point.



Photograph 8: Worts' Causeway
This viewpoint allows elevated views over Cambridge from the Gog Magog Hills. It shows the more sprawling expansion that has occurred to the east and south east of Cambridge, but also demonstrates, through the visibility of landmark features within the historic core, the compactness of the city centre. The lower slopes of the Gog Magog Hills form the rural foreground, with the undulating landform in Sectors 11 and 12 readily apparent.

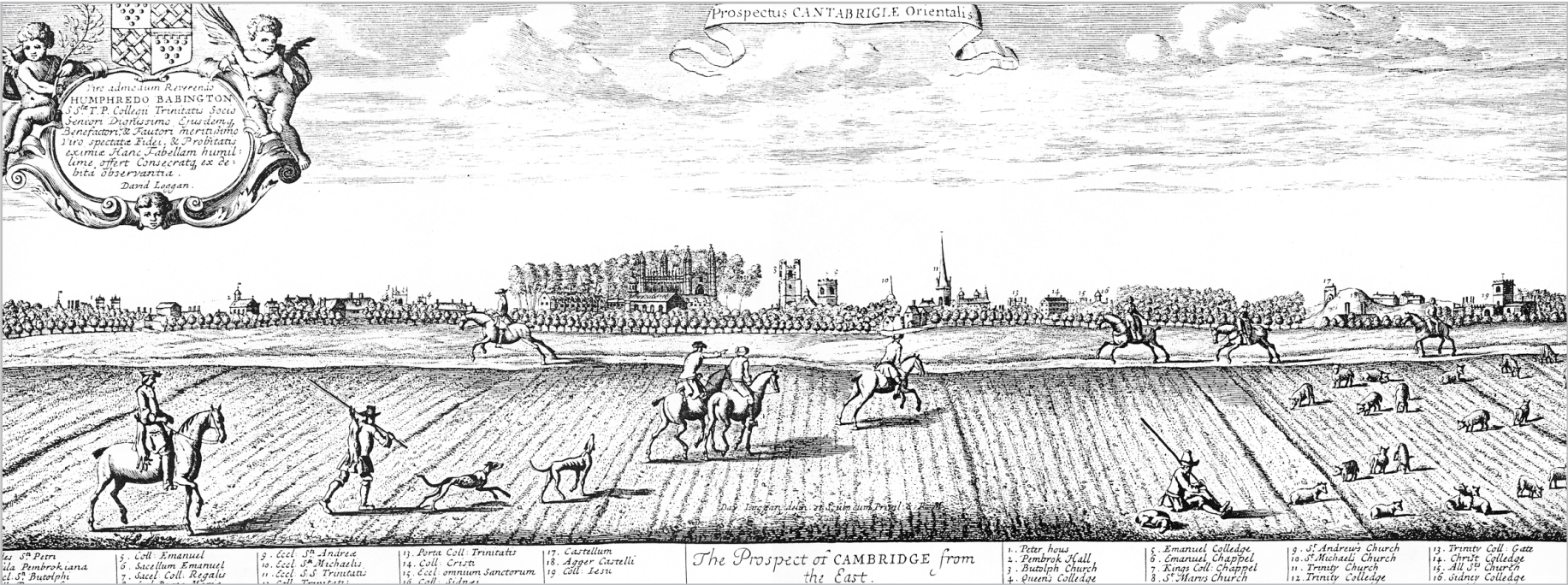


Photograph 9: Airport Way
This viewpoint allows level views across Cambridge Airport, including Sector 17, towards the eastern edge of Cambridge. It demonstrates the rural foreground to views from this side of the city, and illustrates that although this edge of Cambridge is not as vegetated as the western edge, it is still largely green. Landmark features within the historic core are occasionally visible above the vegetation, although the airport hangars are a much more prominent feature.



Photograph 10: Ditton Meadows (Sector 19)
This viewpoint allows views along the green corridor of the River Cam towards the centre of Cambridge. This corridor is a key element of the setting to Cambridge, which passes through the historic core. It is an important green approach into Cambridge for river users and those walking and cycling along the corridor. This view also demonstrates the green edge to Cambridge.
