**Location** The meeting is in the Guildhall on the Market Square (CB2 3QJ).

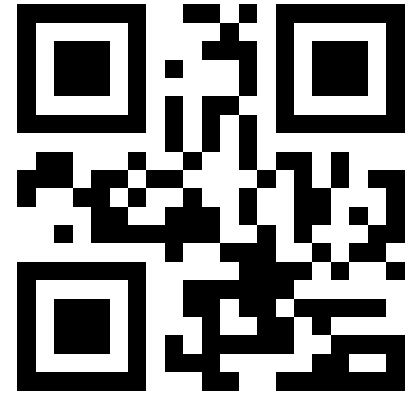
