At the conclusion of the North Area Committee, Cambridgeshire County Council will running a Northern Corridor Area Transport Plan Workshop.

The purpose of the workshop is to update local members, as well as the public, following the May Committee meeting and June workshop, on the process for allocating s106 funding and review the project suggestions made by members that have the potential to be supported by Northern Corridor Area Transport Plan (NCATP) funding. The principal factor for fit with the NCATP is to mitigate the effect of additional transport related movements from new development, with the link to the plan and area covered attached.
