Between March and June 2012, there were 10 reports of abandoned vehicles in the ward compared with 23 during the same period the previous year. This included 4 vehicles, which were not on site following inspection and 1, which was subsequently claimed by their owners. 2 vehicles were also impounded on behalf of the DVLA for not having valid road tax. 2 additional vehicles are also currently pending further investigation. Cromwell Road (3) was the hotspot during the current reporting period. Cavendish Road (3) was the hotspot for the same period the previous year.

Between March and June 2012, there were 30 reports of fly tipping in the ward compared with 47 during the same period the previous year. There was sufficient evidence to issue 7 formal warning letters to domestic offenders and 2 formal warning letters to trade offenders. Argyle Street (3), Hope Street (4) & Mill Road (5) were the main hotspots during the previous year.

Between March and June 2012, 5 derelict cycles were dealt with compared with 3 during the same period the previous year. Mill Road (3) was the main hotspot during the previous year.

Between March and June 2012, 12 needles were reported compared with 25 during the same period the previous year. 9 were removed from Seymour Court. During the previous reporting period 12 needles were removed from Cromwell Road.
