## **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -**
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises, or**
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.**
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.**
- 3. The admission of children under the age of 18 to film exhibitions permitted under the terms of this licence shall be restricted in accordance with any recommendations made:**
  - (a) By the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC), where the film has been classified by that board, or**
  - (b) By the Licensing Authority where no classification certificate has been granted by the BBFC, or, where the licensing authority has notified the licence holder that section 20 (3) (b) of the Licensing Act 2003 applies to the film.**

**From 6<sup>th</sup> April 2010:**

- 4. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.**
- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children-**
  - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-**
    - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or**
    - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);**
  - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);**
  - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;**
  - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-**
    - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or**
    - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;**
  - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.**
- 5. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).**

6. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

From 1<sup>st</sup> October 2010:

7. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

8. The responsible person shall ensure that—

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—

(i) beer or cider: ½ pint;

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

#### **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule**

1. On **Christmas Day** and **New Year's Eve** alcohol shall not be sold, supplied, consumed in or taken from the premises except during permitted hours. In this condition, permitted hours means:

a. On **Christmas Day**, 12:00 to 15:00 and 19:00 to 22:30.

b. On **New Year's Eve**, except on a **Sunday**, 10:00 to 23:00.

c. On **New Year's Eve** on a **Sunday**, 12:00 to 22:30.

d. On **New Year's Eve** from the end of permitted hours on **New Year's Eve** to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

(a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;

(b) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;

(c) during the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied for consumption as ancillary to the meals;

(d) consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;

(e) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;

(f) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;

(g) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;

(h) the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or

(i) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or

(j) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

2. Standard conditions for Cinema Licence as attached will be observed.

The licensee shall comply with such provisions of the Cinematograph (Safety) Regulations 1955 as restrict the use of the premises.

3. This licence is granted on the condition that any other restrictions contained within the enactments specified under the Licensing Act 2003 (Schedule 8 (6)) are adhered to, except relating to S168 of the Licensing Act 1964.

The prevention of crime and disorder

4. The person nominated as the designated premises supervisor will join and actively support the Cambridge Pub and Club watch, whilst it is in existence and support its aims and objectives as given in its charter. This includes support of its agreed banning policy and attending meetings, personally or by sending an authorised representative of the venue.

5. Lighting must be provided outside the premises (and in the premises' private car park) during the hours of darkness when any licensable activity takes place on the premises.

Public Safety

The prevention of public nuisance

6. Regulated entertainment in the form of live and recorded music may only be held between 20.00 hours and 23.00 hours on Fridays, Saturdays and between 12.00 hours and 15.00 hours on Sundays. All other times recorded music to be background only.

7. Live music to be held no more than once per week.

8. Regulated entertainment in the form of live or recorded music will not be played in the conservatory area.

9. When regulated entertainment is held, external doors and external windows to be kept shut at all times during performances, except the front door (that allow general ingress and egress) which shall be kept closed so far as reasonably practicable during events.

10. All Vent Axia fans to be sound insulated to the satisfaction of the Head of Environmental Services.

11. The volume of all recorded music to be controlled by means of a noise limiter set to achieve the following noise levels measured within the premises: 1.5 metres immediately in front of the conservatory doors to the rear (facing Lichfield Road) and side of the premises (facing 45 Perne Road) - LAeq (1 min) = 75 dB.

12. An appropriate sound level meter to be provided and used to monitor the noise levels during regulated entertainment to ensure that agreed levels are complied with.

13. Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at the exit, requesting patrons departing to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

14. No waste with the exception of ash trays will be moved, removed or placed in outside areas between 2300 hrs and 0700 hrs.

The protection of children from harm

15. All children must be accompanied by an adult.

16. On occasions when the venue is open primarily for the sale and consumption of alcohol the DPS or relevant person will actively operate a "Challenge 21" Policy". This

will include a voluntary agreement to only accept identity cards with a "Pass" accreditation, passports or photID driving licences, or any future identification card as approved by central government, as bona-fide recognised forms of identification.

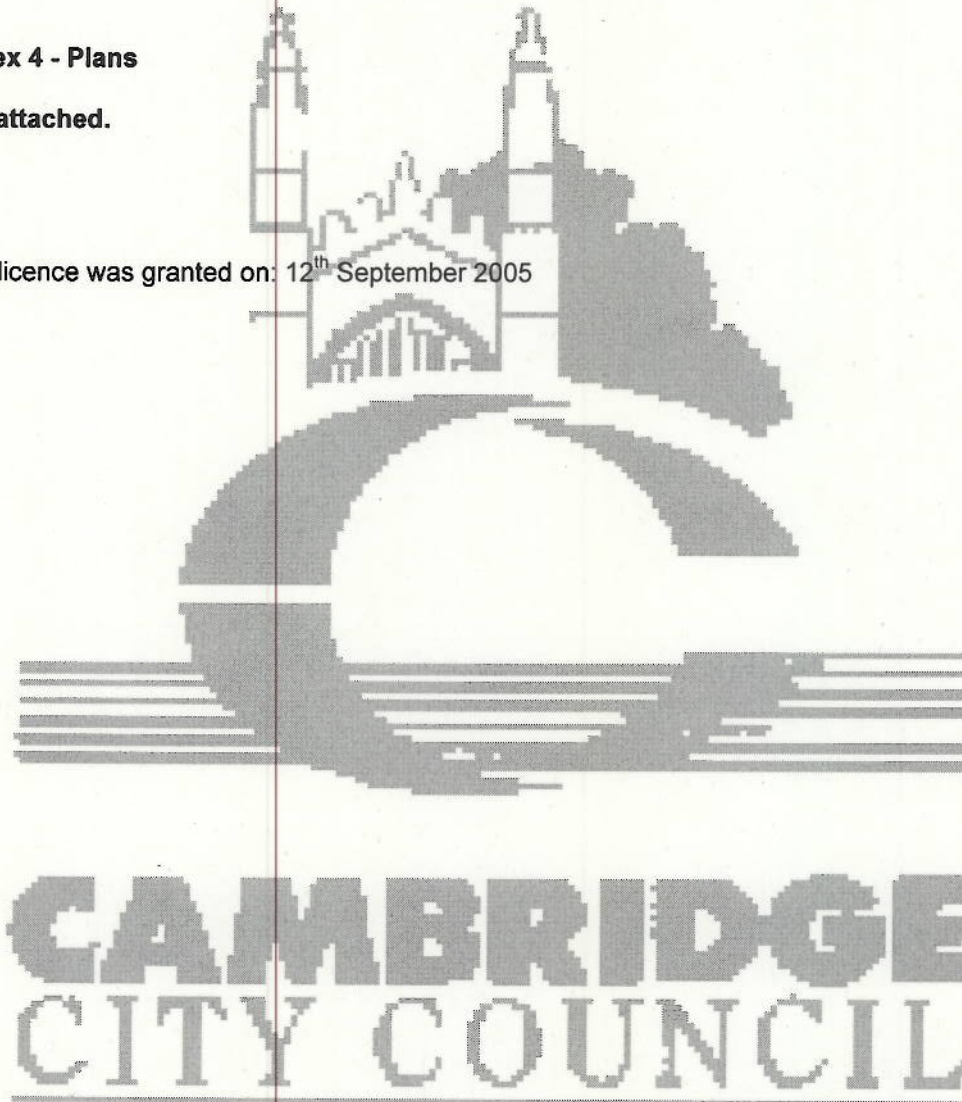

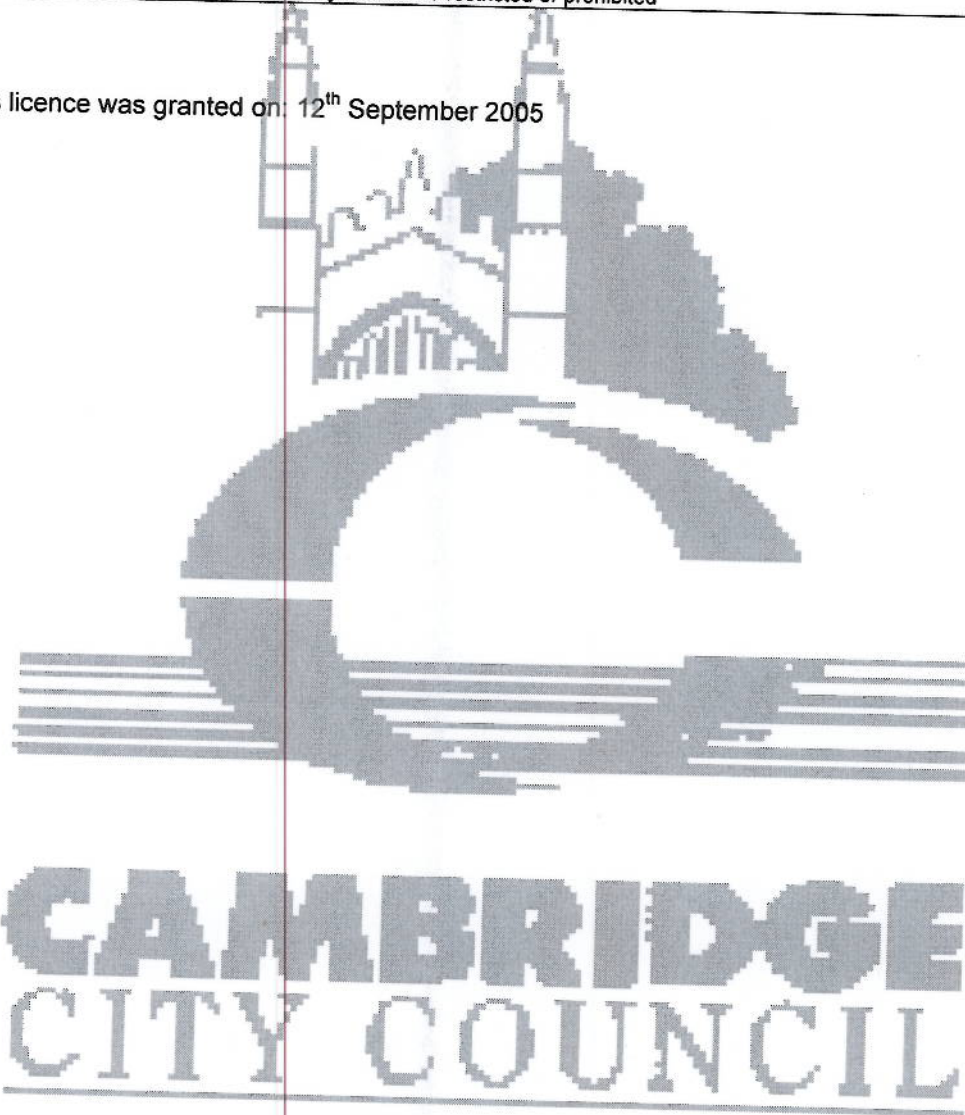
