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What is it?



- 20mph on shopping and residential streets
- Capital Budget of 400k
- 2 to 3 year Programme
- Project Board
- A and B roads not included
- 4 Phases
- Boost the take up of sustainable transport modes
- Reduce personal injury accident severity and associated cost to society

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How is it being done?



- 4 Phase Areas
 - Cost Benefit Analysis
 - North Area, East Area, South Area, West Central Area
- Current Programmed Timeline
 - North Phase Area Consultation in May 2013
 - If positive response at consultation, implementation of North Phase Area during Spring 2014
 - East Phase Area Consultation in Spring 2014
 - Implementation of East Phase Area in Autumn 2014

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Plan of Project Phase Areas

- •Blue roads are A and B
- Dashed red roads are C



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How is it being done?




- Data Collection
 - Used to help identify project design proposals and to identify impact of project if it is installed
 - Data Collected:
 - traffic speed and volume counts using Automatic Traffic Counters (ATCs)
 - accident data from local police
 - cycle counts from ATCs and local counts undertaken by the council

How is it being done?



- Reporting and Decision making
 - For each Phase Area

Stage	Relevant Committee	Why go to this committee?
1	Environmental Scrutiny	To ask to proceed with phase
2	Area Committee	To ask for recommendation on consultation proposals
3	Consultation	
4	Area Committee	To ask for recommendation on how to progress following consultation outcomes
5	Environmental Scrutiny	To ask for authority on whether to proceed with traffic order making through the County Council and implement the phase

How is it being done?



- Design proposals in line with current DfT guidance 'Setting Local Speed Limits'
 - 20mph Zones
 - Entry Points
 - Repeater 20mph signs on existing street furniture
 - 20mph Road marking 'roundels'
 - Can incorporate existing traffic calming so reduce need for additional signs or road markings
 - Remove some existing 'humps ahead' signs
 - Vehicle Activated Signs Relocatable

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Proposed Consultation Method and Material



 Consultation pack sent to all addresses in North Phase Area



- Addressed envelope with note printed on the outside and which contains: Consultation Leaflet, and Questionnaire
- Roads affected illustrated in plan form on the leaflet and in list form on the questionnaire
- Opti<mark>ons</mark> to respond on-line or using freepost address provided
- Distinction drawn between smaller roads and more main roads
- Option to indicate which more main roads are suitable and which are not
- Those from outside the area can respond to the consultation. However their responses will be identifiable as from outside the area

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
