The inclusion of education contributions in the report is incorrect and should be deleted. The UU agreed with the applicant omits this contribution.

The County Archaeological officer has given the following advice.

The site lies in an area of high archaeological potential. The site is located 150m away from the medieval church of St Andrew and the site of a medieval Carmelite friary (HER No's MCB6780 & MCB6502). Numerous other medieval and post-medieval remains are known in the vicinity (HER No's MCB15543, MCB6007, MCB4214 & MCB17901).

The site should therefore be subject to a programme of archaeological investigation and recommend that this work should be commissioned and undertaken at the expense of the developer. This programme of work can be secured through the inclusion of a negative condition such as the model condition 'number 55' contained in DoE Planning Circular 11/95:
