Decision(s) taken: To buy back 34 Aylesborough Close

Decision of: Director of Community and Customer Services

Date of decision: 8 May 2015

Matter for Decision: The acquisition of a dwelling in the city, in line with the HRA Acquisition and Disposal Policy

Any alternative options considered and rejected: The option was to either buy the property back or not.

Reason(s) for the decision including any background papers considered: In line with the HRA Acquisition and Disposal Policy the opportunity to buy back this ex-Council dwelling was offered to the Council. Following the preparation of a business case and consideration of the acquisition in line with the Policy it was decided to acquire the asset from the current owner. The acquisition allowed the Authority to use an element of retained Right to Buy funding as part of the transaction.
