Issues raised at South Area Committee 14 December 2015 regarding bus stops and services:

- Trumpington had high levels of housing but too few stops to get a good bus service near people's houses.
- There was also a lack of pick up points that could be shared with other transport such as mini buses.
- The County Council was likely to cut bus subsidies, which may impact on future services.
- Cherry Hinton had various bus stops, but not many bus services.

Andy Campbell (Managing Director, Stagecoach East) said the following in reponse:

- Trumpington has a 20 minute service with Citi 7. In addition there is an hourly 26 service. Both services serve all stops The Park & Ride also offer a 10 minute service for Porson road. There are also Guideway bus services from Trumpington route A to the City via Addenbrookes and route R direct to the railway station.
- If you are referring to community mini buses they can stop anywhere, although I would suggest the Park & Ride site is probably the best option as it has waiting facilities.
- The majority of our services operate on a commercial basis, I believe the County Council have completed their cuts south of the City.
- Cherry Hinton has two 10 minute services with Citi 1 and Citi 3.
