

Briefing Note – Ice Rink Parker's Piece

A public meeting to discuss issues surrounding the North Pole ice rink on Parker's Piece is to be held on Thursday 21 July from 6pm in the council chamber at the Guildhall.

The meeting has been arranged by Cambridge City Council so interested people can meet the director of Icebox, the company that managed the event on behalf of the council when it was held from November 2015-January 2016.

Richard Elmer of Icebox, along with council officers, will give a presentation on plans for this year's event, including how some of the concerns raised by residents and others about last year's event will be addressed.

Due to the extremely mild and wet weather last winter, some of the turf on Parker's Piece was damaged where the North Pole's ice rink and structures were positioned. The council have since carried out extensive renovation work to restore the turf.
