










Site location plan 1:1250

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -
- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3. Door Supervisors must;
- (a) be authorised to carry out that activity by a licence granted under the Private Security Industry Act 2001; or
- (b) be entitled to carry out that activity by virtue of section 4 of that Act.

From 6th April 2010:

- 4. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children-
- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
- (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
- (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
- (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-
- (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
- (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
- (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- 5. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- 6. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

From 1st October 2010:

- 7. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
- 8. The responsible person shall ensure that-
- (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
- (i) beer or cider: 1/2 pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
- (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours. In this condition, permitted hours means:
- a. On Mondays to Thursdays, other than Christmas Day or New Year's Eve, 10:00 to 23:30.
- b. On Fridays and Saturdays, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or New Year's Eve, 10:00 to 00:00.
- c. On Sundays, other than Christmas Day or New Year's Eve, 11:00 to 23:30.
- d. On Good Friday, 12:00 to 22:30.
- e. On Christmas Day, 12:00 to 15:00 and 19:00 to 22:30.
- f. On New Year's Eve, except on a Sunday, 10:00 to 23:00.
- g. On New Year's Eve on a Sunday, 12:00 to 22:30.
- h. On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).

Alcohol may be sold, supplied, consumed the premises for one hour following the hours set out above and on Christmas day, between 15:00 and 19:00 to persons taking table meals in the premises in a part of the premises usually set apart for the service of such persons and for consumption by such a person in that part of the premises as an ancillary to his meal. For other purposes or in other parts of the premises the hours set out above shall continue to apply.

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

- (a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;
- (b) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- (c) during the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied for consumption as ancillary to the meals;
- (d) consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- (e) the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- (f) the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;

- (g) the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;
- (h) the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or
- (i) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
- (j) the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.
- 2. This licence is granted on the condition that any other restrictions contained within the enactments specified under the Licensing Act 2003 (Schedule 8 (6)) are adhered to.

General

3. The licensee reserves the right to move fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines and any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location in a way that does not impact upon the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routed without impediment.

The prevention of crime and disorder

- 4. Door supervisors will be used or employed at times when a licensable activity is taking place and it is considered necessary to:
- prevent the admission and ensure the departure from the premises of drunk and disorderly persons, without causing further disorder;
- keep out excluded individuals (subject to court or pub watch bans);
- search and exclude persons suspected of carrying illegal drugs or offensive weapons; or
- maintain an orderly queue outside the venue.
- 5. Lighting must be provided outside the premises during the hours of darkness when any licensable activity takes place on the premises.

Public Safety

- 6. Maintained illuminated fire exit notices must be displayed above each final exit door and at any change of direction. They must be illuminated at all time when the premises are in use.
- 7. Emergency lighting must not be altered without the prior notification to the Licensing Authority.
- 8. At least one trained first aider will be on duty when the public are present.
- 9. A fire alarm should be installed and maintained in working order.

The prevention of public nuisance

- 10. Background music only to be played after 23.00.
- 11. During entertainment windows and doors are to remain closed.
- 12. The licence holder shall effect and maintain in a prominent position at every exit a clear and conspicuous notice, requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises without causing noise, nuisance or disturbance to the local residents. Staff will steward exits from the premises at closing times to remind departing patrons.

The protection of children from harm


- 13. No unaccompanied person under the age of 18 will be permitted into the premises.
