Matter for Decision:	To provide additional play equipment within the existing play area on Lammas Land in Newnham at an estimated cost of £20,000, funded from S106 contributions for Children's Play		
Why the decision had to be made (and any alternative options):	<p>The need for an urgent is due to the nature of the funding stream as the financial support for this project is to come from a time limited Section 106 contribution. These funds are time limited and due to expire on 28/10/2010.</p> <p>As the project is not on the capital plan, approval needs to be made and would of been made within the normal timeline, but as the decision for the adoption of the Medium Term Strategy which approves all additions to the capital plan has been delayed from Full Council on 21/10/2010 until the Special meeting 08/11/10 the decision and authority to spend the funds will no longer fall within the required funding dates of the S106 agreement and funds will therefore be liable to be returned.</p> <p>As specified under Part 4C 6.1.2 of the Councils Constitution, It was not deemed practical to convene a quorate meeting of Council to take these decisions.</p>		
The Executive Councillor's decision(s):	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recommend this capital scheme to the Leader for approval and inclusion in the Capital Plan as an Urgent Decision, subject to resources being available to fund the capital cost associated with the Scheme. The total capital cost of the project is estimated at £20,000, funded from S106 contributions for Children's Play.		
Reasons for the decision:	<p>As stated in Part 4C section 6.1 of the Councils Constitution, individual members of the Executive 'may take a decision which is contrary or not wholly in accordance with the budget approved by the full Council if the decision is a matter of urgency'.</p> <p>Due to time pressures it was deemed not practical to convene a quorate meeting of Council to take these decisions</p>
