

# **Environmental Report: Cambridge North Area December 2016 to February 2017**

## **Briefing note:**

Officers have undertaken work on the priorities previously set, and in light of the evidence found over the last three months have recommended a change in some of the areas of work for the upcoming period.

Changes include:

- Adding areas for fly tipping patrols at: Hazelwood/Molewood Close area, Church Street recycling centre and Edgecombe/ Cadwin field area.
- Changing dog fouling patrols to focus on Perse Way area
- Introducing a new priority to tackle littering outside shops on Chesterton High Street

The report sets out the statistical data for Environmental Health, Enforcement, Streets and Open Spaces Operations and Waste over the period of December 2016 to February 2017.

A small quantity of recycling and general street litter bins, and dog poo bins are stills available for each ward.
