Summary of public realm data:

Fly tipping:

- Of the 51 reports for fly tip in the Arbury ward, six came from Hazelwood Close; eight from Molewood Close and six from Rutland Close no other particular trends with types of fly tipped material were identified in this period. In East Chesterton, there were repeat incidents at Church Street at the recycling centre and no other trends for fly tipping in this ward were identified. In Kings Hedges the majority of waste was fly tipped in and around communal areas and recycling areas of the estates. Thirteen fly tips were from Nicholson Way, ten from Campkin Road, nine from Cadwin Field / Edgecombe areas and eight from Minerva Way areas. No patterns of repeat offences have been identified. Repeat fly tips were found in Hawthorn Way and Woodhead Drive areas of West Chesterton. No patterns of repeat offences have been identified.
