Fulbourn Greenway Project

The Fulbourn Greenway project received approval to proceed from the GCP Executive Board in February 2020. A report detailing the consultation results can be downloaded from the following link and I also attach an infographic with some of the headline results from the consultation.

Since February the Greater Cambridge Partnership has been undertaking a procurement exercise to award a framework contract for professional services (planning, design, legal etc.). Contractors from this framework will then be tasked with making rapid progress on the schemes for which they are commissioned. Unfortunately due to circumstances related to the covid19 pandemic there has been some delays to the award of the contract but it is now expected to be awarded within weeks.

Improvements to the Snakey Path are a high priority, not least due to safety concerns over the deterioration of the path. We intend to work in partnership with colleagues at the City Council and our team has already had early discussions with the City Council around what is possible and what constraints need to be considered. Path width around protected trees, multiple ecological issues related to proximity to Cherry Hinton brook and land ownership constraints are all matters that we are aware will need to be overcome in the planning and design of the scheme.

Once we know which contractors we will be working with and have started to develop detailed plans we will be keen to engage further with all local stakeholders prior to any works taking place.
