South Environmental Data Report 1st June 2020 – November 2020

During this period all three wards have been regularly patrolled. Increased patrols of Play Areas and Recreation Grounds during lock-down restrictions. Continued working in conjunction with residents, friends of groups and supporting volunteers. Monitoring of social distancing measures in place.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions the investigation process has been curtailed. Interviews have been suspended, therefore situation depending, education, advice and Warning letters have been used as an alternative to Fixed Penalty Notices and prosecutions. Un-taxed vehicle investigations suspended.

CHERRY HINTON:

Church End – (July) One suspected abandoned vehicle investigated. Vehicle claimed by the registered keeper who subsequently moved the vehicle off the public highway. (November) Suspected abandoned vehicle reported, investigation on-going.

Teversham Drift – (August) furniture found dumped. Investigation conducted and a suspect identified. Report received, garden waste dumped in a passage way. Site visited and the resident engaged, resulting in the waste safely cleared.

Queens Meadow – (June) Suspected abandoned vehicle reported. Investigated and the vehicle claimed by owner.

Kathleen Elliott Way – (June) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated. Vehicle claimed by registered keeper. (September) Suspected abandoned vehicle reported. Investigation conducted and the vehicle was removed from the site by keeper. (October) Suspected abandoned vehicle reported, which is currently still under investigation.

Railway Street – (July) Suspected abandoned vehicle reported. Investigation conducted and the vehicle was moved by keeper.

Chartfield Road – (August) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated. The vehicle was subsequently moved from the site by keeper.

Fishers Lane – (September) Black bag dumped next to the bus stop – no evidence to found. (October) Investigation into a suspected abandoned vehicle parked on the grass verge. The vehicle was subsequently removed from the site by keeper. **(Photo 1)**

Wenvoe Close – (August) Mattress and bed frame dumped on the pavement. Suspect was identified during investigation. Advise provided and a correct method for the disposal of the waste organised. **(Photo 2)**

Colville Road – Over the period there has continued to be an on-going problem with illegally dumped waste next to the textile recycling point in the car park. (July, August & September) Household items such as furniture, carpets, fridges and other general waste dumped at the site. Six investigations conducted, resulting in an **FPN 19** issued for fly-tipping. This area has now been closed due to construction work. **(Photo 3)**

Mallets Road – (September) Household items dumped on the grass verge. Suspect identified during investigation.

Drayton Road – (November) Furniture dumped on grass verge – investigated but no suspect identified.

Leete Road – (June) Moped dumped in passage way at the rear of properties. Removed to storage by CCC and subsequently handed over to the Police for further investigation.

High Street – (October) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated. The vehicle was removed from the site by keeper. (November) Three businesses issued waste receptacles notices (EPA 1990 Sec 47) after it was identified that waste produced from the businesses was contributing to littering the area.

Cherry Hinton Recreation Ground – (October) Two incidents of illegal camping on the recreation ground. No occupants identified. Both tents were removed by CCC and held in storage for 28 days

Chelwood Road – Litter from vehicle witnessed, **FPN1** issued.

Cherry Hinton Hall – (July) Moped dumped and burnt out at the Hall grounds. The Moped was removed by CCC, investigated and destroyed. (Photo 4) (August & October) incidents of general waste being dumped in the car park next to the clothing recycling bin. Three investigations conducted but no suspects identified.

Ventress Farm Court – (September) suspected abandoned vehicle investigated. Vehicle claimed by the registered keeper.

Greystoke Road – (October) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated. Vehicle claimed by the registered keeper.

Glenacre Close – (October) Builders waste protruding onto the public highway. Contact made with the builders and resident. Education and advice provided for correct management of the waste.

Langdale Close – (July) A sofa, wooden furniture and cardboard found dumped. Investigation conducted and a suspect was identified.

Illegal advertising –(October) Throughout Cherry Hinton, on street furniture, A4 posters displayed illegally. Company responsible identified and issued a **Community Protection Notice** – Warning Letter.

TRUMPINGTON:

Monkswell – (July) BBQ and wooden cabinet dumped. (August) Carpet and household items dumped. (October) Large TV box and metal frame dumped. All three incidents investigated but unable to identify any suspects!

Byron's Square Public Recycling Point – On-going problem of non-recyclable waste being dumped at the site. (July) black bags containing general waste and cardboard dumped at the site. Searched conducted but not evidence found. (August) Three incidents of waste dumped at the site including two fridges, child's buggy, other household items and a microwave! August also saw a large quantity of clothing being left in bags next to the textiles bin which was closed due to covid-19 restrictions. (September) Cardboard box filled with paint trays found dumped at the site. Following an investigation an FPN 1 issued for littering. (October) Large amount of cardboard found outside of the receptacles. Suspect identifies and investigated, resulting in an FPN 1 issued for littering. (Photo 1)

King George V Memorial Playing field – (June) Unauthorised encampment consisting of multiple Caravans and vehicles. The site was managed for approximately a week until clear (July) Unauthorised encampment of one Caravan managed for approximately three weeks until clear.

Lingrey Court – (June) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated, on return visit it was no longer at the site

Anstey Way – (July) Sofa dumped on the pavement. (August) Black bag dumped on footpath. Searched but no evidence found. **(Photos 2-3)**

Osprey Drive – (June) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated and subsequently claimed by the registered keeper.

Richard Foster Road – (July) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated, on return visit it was no longer at the site

Vicarage Way – (July) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated and subsequently claimed by the registered keeper.

Glebe Farm Drive Public Recycling Point - On-going problem of non-recyclable waste being dumped at this site. Working in partnership with residents and Shared Waste to take steps to reduce fly-tipping at the site. New signage to be installed and increased monitoring of the area. (July) Fridge dumped at the site. (August) Large quantity of plastic containers, carpet and other non-recyclable items dumped. (September) Non – recyclable household waste dumped. (November) Non-recyclable items dumped at the site. (Photos 4-7)

Glebe Farm Drive - (August) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated. Vehicle claimed by the registered keeper.

Overhill Close – (October) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated, vehicle not abandoned, claimed by the registered keeper.

Hobson Avenue – (June) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated, on return visit it was no longer at the site.

Lime Avenue – Littering from vehicle witnessed, **FPN 1** issued.

Byron's Pool Car Park – (June) Suspect abandoned vehicle investigated and claimed by the registered keeper. (September) Vehicle declared abandoned, investigation conducted, and vehicle was removed by CCC to 21-day storage. (Photo 8)

Trumpington Road – Littering from vehicle witnessed, **FPN 1** issued.

Hills Road – (June) At the junction with Brooklands Avenue, littering from vehicle witnessed, **FPN1** issued (October) Incident of a business failing to manage waste correctly. The business is already subject to a section 47 Waste Notice, therefore an **FPN 7** issued for failing to comply with the Waste Notice.

St Pauls Road – Littering offence witnessed, FPN 1 issued

Norwich Street – (June) Suspected abandoned vehicle investigated and claimed by the registered keeper.

Bateman street – (September) Bins on street problem reported. Waste education visits conducted, on-going monitoring.

Aberdeen Avenue – (June) Abandoned property, including a small tent, removed from the site and stored for 28 days.

Station Road – (June) Littering offence witnessed, **FPN 1** Issued. (July) Illegal advertising on street furniture. The business responsible identified and received a Warning

Glenalmond Avenue – (August & September) Six reported suspected abandoned vehicles in this area. Investigations conducted revealing a parking issue for resident due to bays being used to store vehicles.

Nine Wells Road – (Nov) Suspected abandoned vehicle reported. Attended the site, vehicle no longer in situ.


