In the event that vibration complaints are received a lower alert noise level is triggered, it is noted that a lower alert investigation should be made to ascertain the cause and implement mitigation where necessary.
- Delete Para 10.20 and insert wording as follows: The local member's and school's comments regarding this submission are noted. Whilst condition 8 details are yet to be discharged and said condition submission (22/02066/CONDF) has been called in separately by the local member, the compliance limb of Condition 8 restricts demolition works to school holidays only and must be carried out irrespective of the details submitted to satisfy the other elements of said condition. On this basis, officers consider that the acceptability of the condition 7 submission (22/02066/CONDL) is not reliant on the details submitted under condition 8 (22/02066/CONDF). Whilst timetable information has been requested by the local member, this is not required by condition 7. In conclusion, the information has been assessed against the requirements of condition 7 and is deemed to be acceptable on this basis.
