7. Cambridge Delivery Company: Update Report

8. CIP Loan Facility

The Chair ruled that under 100B(4)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972 the late item be considered despite not being made publicly available for this committee five clear days prior to the meeting.

The Committee endorsed the recommendations.

The Executive Councillor:

- i. Approved a capital budget for 3 loan facilities amounting to £18,500,000, to be provided to Cambridge Investment Partnership (CIP) and to be utilised solely for the purposes of Housing delivery, including regeneration activities and new build development at Newbury Farm, ATS/Murketts Histon Rd, and Fanshawe Road.
- ii. Delegated authority to the Chief Finance Officer to make arrangements for capital financing of the loans in accordance with relevant statutory guidance and the council's Treasury Management Strategy and Capital Strategy.
- iii. Approved the setting of interest rates applicable to the 3 loan facilities at 3.5% margin above 5-year Gilt Rates.
- iv. Delegated authority to the Chief Finance Officer to agree the detailed terms of the loans, including (but not limited to) availability period, drawdown dates and arrangements, pricing dates, and restrictive covenants.

9. Cambridge Leisure Development Proposal

The Scrutiny Committee resolved to exclude members of the public from the meeting on the grounds that, if they were present, there would be disclosure to them of information defined as exempt from publication by virtue of paragraphs 3 and 5 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.
